NEMT

Services Provided: The Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT) program provides eligible members transportation needed to get to their medical appointments.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Medicaid members who must be able to get to and from their medically necessary appointments.
- Members must have no other means of transportation available.
- Transportation is only for medical services covered under the Medicaid program.

MARTA

Services Provided: Reduced fare program for general transportation.
