**Services Provided:** The Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT) program provides eligible members transportation needed to get to their medical appointments.

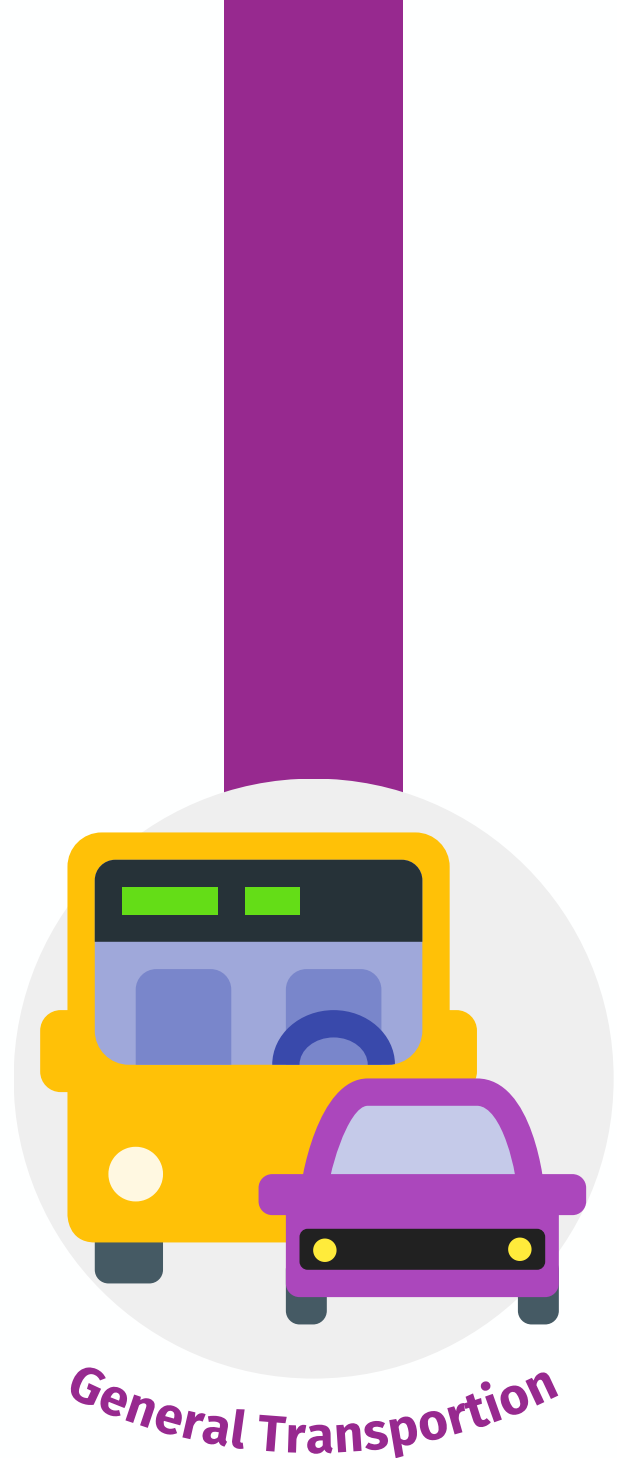
**Eligibility Requirements:**

- Transportation is only for medical services covered under the Medicaid program.
